Buether Joe & Carpenter Secures Patent Defense Win at Trial for Stealth Cam LLC and GSM, Inc.

DALLAS (November 27, 2104) Buether Joe & Carpenter secured a complete defense win for Stealth Cam LLC, a subsidiary of Good Sportsman Marketing, Inc., in a patent infringement suit brought by Larry Holmberg in Minnesota.

The verdict was announced on November 25, 2014, after a six-day jury trial before Judge Donovan W. Frank in the United States District Court for the District of Minnesota. The jury found that Stealth Cam did not infringe Holmberg's '196 patent and found Holmberg's '038 patent invalid without reaching a verdict on the issue of infringement of that patent. Holmberg's patents related to mounting a camera to a weapon for use in game hunting. The accused products were Stealth Cam's "EPIC" action camera products.

Holmberg filed the suit in February 2011, eventually asserting four patents against Stealth Cam. Before trial, Judge Frank granted summary judgment of non-infringement in favor of Stealth Cam on two of the four patents.

"Our client is extremely pleased with the verdict," said Eric Buether who served as lead trial counsel for Stealth Cam. "The jury did a remarkable job considering the evidence and weighing the facts."
